JROTC/ROTC Committee Report January 2024

All chapter committee chairmen have been alerted to the 2024 deadlines that must be met to assure that LASSAR complies with deadlines established by the chairman of NSSAR JROTC/ROTC affairs. Our local deadlines are:

NO later than January 14, 2024, JROTC SMI's should begin urging their best high school junior cadets to start working on their essays and applications to compete for the "Enhanced Award" at the local, state and national levels.

No later than March 1, 2024, ALL JROTC and ROTC unit SMI's should select the most outstanding who should receive the Bronze Medal (JROTC high school junior only) or Silver Medal (ROTC only). The SMI has complete discretion in determining the cadet and only one cadet per unit may be submitted to each LASSAR Chapter.

No later than March 15, 2024, JROTC SMI 's should submit the one best "Enhanced Award" essay and application to the appropriate LASSAR Chapter JROTC Committee Chairman.

No later than April 1, 2024, LASSAR Chapter JROTC Chairmen should submit to the State Chairman the best "Enhanced Award" essay and application.

All LASSAR Chapters are encouraged to continue vigorously promoting our JROTC and ROTC outstanding cadet recognition programs and to push for strong JROTC Enhanced Award participation and competition.

LASSAR has sponsored two national first place winners in the JROTC Enhanced Award competitions in years past and we can do it again! I am requesting that each of our chapters continue promoting the JROTC Enhanced Award to the maximum extent possible.

The Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway was dedicated with signs during a ceremony held at Fire Station 5 just west of Dixie Inn, LA on May 19. The dedication signs are located at mile marker 40 (eastbound) and mile marker 43 (westbound) on Interstate 20.

A large crowd of veterans and community leaders gathered for the highway dedication ceremony, showing that the highway signs are an important acknowledgment of Vietnam veterans service to the United States.

Galvez Chapter Compatriot Jerry Madden recognized the need for increased recognition of Vietnam veterans in the spring of 2021 and initiated the highway sign project with LA-DOTD at that time and led the project through to its completion.



LA State Representative Dr. Wayne McMahen pushed the highway dedication and sign approval through the legislature and was the first to donate to have the signs made. Spencer Creech of Minden earned the Congressional Award for Youth Bronze Medal. During a Town Hall meeting at Bossier Parish Community College, Congressman Mike Johnson presented Spencer with a certificate from his office and a medal that was struck at the U.S. Mint. Spencer was also invited to open the meeting by leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

Compatriot Jerry Madden served as Spencer's program advisor. To earn the award, Spencer documented over 100 hours of community volunteer service in three categories: honoring veterans, helping people in need, and historic preservation.

Established in 1979, the Congressional Award is the highest honor bestowed upon a youth civilian through the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives. Congress established the award to recognize initiative, service, and achievement in young people.

SAR and DAR Chapters Celebrate the Signing of the U.S. Constitution (Nov 21, 2023)

SAR Galvez Chapter and DAR Chapters Dorcheat – Bistineau, Pelican, and Shreveport sponsored the wreath placing ceremony to pay respect and honor to Patriots George Washington, Thomas Jefferson and James Madison at the Galvez Bi-centennial monument in Bossier City.

To celebrate the Bi-centennial of the U.S. Constitution, The Galvez Chapter designed, constructed and placed the SAR monument at the Bossier City Government Complex in 1988. Ted Sherman, a local architect, agreed to design it and Compatriot Bill Snead persuaded Central Monument Company to carve and place it at the chosen site in Bossier City.

Three historic patriots are depicted on the face of the monument —Washington, Jefferson, and Madison. George Washington, as our first President and Commander in Chief, is displayed in the middle. To his right is Thomas Jefferson, author of the Declaration of Independence and to his left is James Madison, the "Father" of the U.S. Constitution.

"In celebration of the Bicentennial of the signing of the Constitution for the United States of America," is inscribed on the front of the monument and "Praise the power that hath made and preserved us as nation and this be our motto 'In God We Trust'" is inscribed on the back and the SAR seal is displayed. The Bi-centennial monument was dedicated September 21,1988.







Past Chapter President Sandy McNeely was awarded the Patriot Medal by the Louisiana SAR for his long and faithful service. McNeely had served as Chapter President for 10 years. Chapter President Tony L. Vets informed the members that the Patriot Medal is awarded only by a state society, and states are allowed to give one for every 500 members. Louisiana is allowed two medals per year. It is the highest award given for service at the state or chapter level. This medal is presented only to individuals and may be received **ONLY** once. It represents long, faithful and outstanding service at the state and/or chapter level. The medal is silver color and bears the portrait of Compatriot General of the Army Douglas MacArthur on the obverse within the inscription, "The National Society of the Sons of the American Revolution." The medal is suspended from a chest ribbon of royal blue color. The design for the medal was selected by Compatriot MacArthur. He received the first medal, presented posthumously at his tomb in Norfolk, Virginia, on October 19, 1964, where it is on permanent display.

Joining Vets in making the presentation to McNeely is Past VPG and State President James A. Morock. MD.




